



Center for Medical Simulation CA-3 Month Rotation Elective

Introduction:

The Center for Medical Simulation (MS) is a training facility operated by the four Harvard Anesthesia Departments that is geared toward enhancing clinical decision-making and team building. Residents may spend a month rotation at CMS where they participate in planning programs, learning and teaching about critical events in the context of realistic simulation.

The Center offers a variety of training programs for Anesthesia as well as Emergency Medicine, Radiology Code Teams, Medical Students and other personnel who mat face dynamic clinical situations. Participants are asked to manage patients during basic care through critical events in a realistic simulated environment. Video cameras are used to capture the event and become an integral part of the training methodology. An experienced faculty member debriefs the scenarios. These facilitated sessions cover medical issues as well as communication, teamwork, decision-making and leadership. The feedback is provided in a supportive and positive manner with the intention of motivating improved performance. The curriculum used to develop the scenarios is based on real hospital events.

Elective Goals:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the principles of crisis resource management by assisting the CMS faculty in facilitating courses offered during the elective month.
- Share with fellow residents in the gained knowledge of managing potentially catastrophic events
- Learn group dynamics and effective communications skills.

Activities:

- Participate in all roles during Crisis Resource Management (CRM) courses
- Participate in developing, preparing, refining and validating scenarios to be used in CRM courses.
- Read the literature regarding critical event management, teamwork, organizational behavior and errors in medicine.
- Participate in on-going projects as directed.

Deliverables:

- Develop and coordinate one new scenario to be used during a CRM course.
- Add to the pre-existing computerized patient database by creating realistic lab results and patient histories for various disease states.
- Write a one page reflective summary of the experience gained through the rotation.
